Entries not on the official entry form or without agreement and rules WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. Entries received without fees, postdated checks, or returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. Credit cards and electronic payments will not beaccepted for this trial. The Trial Secretary will add a \$30 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Refunds of \$8 or less will not be issued due to the cost of processing.
