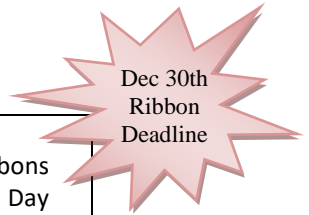

Facility, Check-in, Crating & Food

- Waggin' Tails doors will be open at 8:00 AM. Please do not arrive prior to this time.
- Dogs may be crated in the facility; we have a separate crating room. The main crating room is upstairs; there is accessible crating downstairs for those who need, just let us know.
- Some chairs are available to competitors; you may wish to bring your own.
- The site is wheelchair accessible. It's a nice quiet parking lot with some shade if you wish to work out of your car.
- There is a kitchen on site. Area restaurants and fast food are also within a short driving distance of trial site. Snacks, Coffee, Soda, Water, and light nibbles will be available.

From Route 495, Exit 32 (coming southbound go right, Northbound go left) to Boston Road heading west. Left turn at Westford Village green (road ends), take second right (first right is dead end) onto Graniteville Rd. Continue On Graniteville Rd, until crossing the railroad bridge (high chain link fence both sides) take first immediate left onto Broadway St. Waggin' Tails is on the right in a small industrial park across from a church.

From Rt 3, Exit 33 for MA/40, left on MA/40/Groton Rd – 3.6 miles slight left for North street (signs for Forge Village), 0.8 miles continue onto N Main St, 0.1 mile turn left on Broadway, Waggin' tails is on your left in about 500 ft.

Classes

- The Novice A class shall be for dogs who have not earned any other obedience title or a rally obedience title in any registry. The Novice B class shall be for dogs who have earned an obedience title or a rally obedience title in any registry. The Novice C class shall be for dogs who have earned a CDSP Novice title (CD-C or CD-H) in either the A or B class. The Novice order of exercises shall apply.
- The Starter Novice A class shall be for dogs who have not earned any other obedience title in any registry and does not have a qualifying score (Q) in Novice in any obedience registry. The Starter Novice B class shall be for dogs who have earned a Beginner Novice (BN) obedience title or equivalent in any registry and does not have a qualifying score (Q) in Novice in any obedience registry. The Starter Novice C class shall be for dogs who have earned a CDSP Starter Novice title (SN-C) in either the A or B class and does not have a qualifying score (Q) in Novice in any obedience registry. The Starter Novice order of exercises shall apply.
- The Open A class shall be for dogs who have earned the CDSP Novice obedience title (CD-C or CD-H.) The Open B class shall be for dogs who have earned the CDSP Novice obedience title (CD-C or CD-H) and/or any other Open obedience titles in any registry. The Open C class shall be for dogs who have earned a CDSP Open title (CDX-C or CDX-H) in either the A or B class. Any of the Open C order of exercises may be used.
- The Utility A class shall be for dogs who have earned the CDSP Open obedience title (CDX-C or CDX-H.) The Utility B class shall be for dogs who have earned the CDSP Utility obedience title (UD-C or UD-H.) Any of the Utility B order of exercises may be used. A dog may compete in Utility B indefinitely. The Utility C class is for dogs who have earned their OTCH-C and UDX-C.

Awards:

A Qualifying Ribbon will be awarded to each team who earns a score of 170 or higher in each class. Placement ribbons will be given to the top four scoring teams in each class. A, B and C classes are placed separately.

First Place- Blue Second Place- Red Third Place- Yellow Fourth Place- White

New Title Ribbons will be given to any team earning a new title at our trials.

A High in Trial rosette will be given for the highest scoring team in that trial.



- See details about jump height for High Jump, Bar Jump and Broad Jump at the CDSP Website.
- Dogs 7 years and older may follow Veterans guidelines for jump height.
- The **minimum** jump height will be 4 inches; maximum will be 22 inches.
- The broad jump will be set at twice the dog's jump height.
- Owners may complete an Exercise Modification form for dogs unable to jump the height listed due to physical limitation according to the CDSP guidelines.
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Notice to Competitors

Competitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of CDSP Obedience rules and regulations including but not limited to the following rules regarding entry:

- This trial is open to all dogs being at least six months of age, including purebred and non-purebred, except bitches in season or dogs with disabilities, injuries or illnesses which may cause the dog pain or great discomfort, or dogs exhibiting signs of aggression that threaten the safety of other dogs or humans.
 - All dogs must be registered with CDSP Obedience to compete. A one-time registration form is available and must be submitted DIRECTLY to the CDSP Obedience office (NOT to trial hosting organization) before the date that a team first submits an entry in a sanctioned trial. We regret we cannot accept an entry without a valid CDSP registration number.
 - Dogs must be shown by a member of the owner's immediate family: mother, father, spouse, life partner, sibling, child, grandparent, or grandchild.
 - Safety shall always be of foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times. Handlers, through entry at this event, accept full responsibility for themselves and the actions of their dogs.
 - The organizing committee may refuse any entry for any reason.
 - THERE SHALL BE NO REFUND for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of reason for such dismissal. A dog or handler who suffers an injury and/or illness or bitches that come into season after the closing date may be eligible for a 50% refund of their total entry fee. Written request for refund must be made to the Trial Secretary BEFORE the end of the event, January 23, 2015. Please provide documentation from your veterinarian/physician. There will be no refunds if the trial has to be cancelled for any reason.
 - Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for returned checks. Payment of entry fees and service charges shall be made in cash or money order within 30 days of postmark of notice of returned check where notification is received after event date. Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event or entry is cancelled without recourse by owner/handler.
 - No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, and public emergency, act of a public enemy, strike or any other cause beyond the control of the organizers.
 - All dogs shall be shown in a flat buckle or snap collar, plain harness, or properly fitted martingale (limited slip) collar. No choke collar, prong collars, shock collars, no-pull harnesses, martingale leads, or head collars are allowed.
 - All competitors through entry at this event waive any and all rights relative to video broadcast of this event. Competitors shall have the right to videotape portions of this event for their personal use only. No portion of this event may be videotaped for commercial or other purposes. All video, broadcast, and telecast rights for this event are the exclusive property of the CDSP or the trial host(s).
 - Owners with disabilities are encouraged to compete. Any necessary modifications to the exercises must be provided by the handler to the judge and approved by the judge.
 - Dogs with disabilities are allowed and encouraged to compete provided that the dog does not show evidence of being in pain or discomfort.
 - Upon successful completion of each exercise, the owner may choose to give the dog food as a reward. Food may NOT be used as a lure to help the dog complete an exercise. Food rewards must be contained in pockets and only be present in the owner's hand upon completion of all features of an exercise after the judge has said "Exercise Finished". This must be done before the team begins to move forward to the next exercise as directed by the judge.

- Dogs must remain under control at all times whether on or off leash while on show grounds. Day kenneling only is permitted. There is plenty of parking, indoor crating. Please pick up after your dog and yourself.
 - This event will be held indoors on rubber matting.

I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, appearance, theft, damage, or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.
